“Applying any basic principle of finance to the balance sheet of the U.S. economy/government, one will have no choice but to conclude that the U.S. is and has been, for several decades, financially bankrupt” Greco states. He delves into the irresponsible behaviors and practices by the governing body from the New Deal to the present and the devastating ricochet affects those behaviors have had on everything from Healthcare, The Federal Reserve, the National Debt and The People’s faith in their government.
