Greco makes the case that in order for the original American ideal of self-governance (true republicanism) to flourish, individuals and the government should return to the words and values laid forth in the Constitution, which spells out an acceptable and agreeable code of conduct for government. Specifically, an individual's right to own and sell property, to create a system where there is a healthy exchange of goods and services in the spirit of one's freedom to pursue prosperity. The government has, however, systematically imposed programs and legalities designed perhaps to enhance prosperity, but in practice, actually impede it. He cites specific programs such as the New Deal, The National Labor Relations Act, Roe v. Wade, and most recently The Patriot Act as examples of potentially good intentions and ideas that have been manipulated and twisted into harmful and preventative measures.

VALOR IN PROSPERITY proposes a FUNCTIONAL stimulus as a remedy to the nation's ills. Greco suggests reconstitution, a total overhaul of the electoral process, as well as the monetary, legislative, judicial and military systems. This third installment of the Blind Vision Series is ultimately hopeful and inspiring by posing some fascinating changes that would "fix" this government, and by extension, this country.
