His thesis is that government masks its toxicity through the tool of conflict. He examines the economic implications of globalism, labor costs, free trade/protectionism; the social implications of taxation, entitlement programs, and religion; and the legal implications of immigration, free and open borders, cheap labor, and associated health concerns.

The expansion of legislation/judicial authority is also considered. Greco concludes that Selective Ideals are perpetuated by an elective process that flouts republican ideals; in essence elevating clearly biased intentions over the will of the people. Rather than championing the causes of freedom and liberty, our politicians entice voters with promises that will, ultimately, limit that freedom and liberty. We, the people, must be alert to the temptations and allure of immense power.

Although the jeopardy is real, Greco remains optimistic that the creative genius and economic vitality here at the founding of America can be recaptured. These hopes and ideas are further explored, and solutions offered, in the subsequent volumes in the Blind Vision Series, VALUE GIVEN, VALUE RECEIVED (March 2010) and VALOR IN PROSPERITY (May 2010.)
